<b>Activity:</b> Woodcutter game	<b>Season:</b> Any
<b>Area:</b> Open area	
<b>Learning Objectives:</b> MD CL&L PD CD K&UW PSED	
CD - using imagination, role play	
<b>Key Words:</b>	
Tree, woodcutter, chainsaws, axe, cut, saw, pile, log, branch, twig, leaves, trunk	
<b>Resources:</b>	
People, imagination!	
<b>Activity details:</b>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Half your group trees, form a forest waving in the breeze, arms branches, body trunk, fingers leaves.</li><li>2. Other half choose how you want to cut down 'trees' e.g. chop with axe, saw. The woodcutters approach tree children and cut down (tree children fall to ground)</li><li>3. Cut 'trees' down and make pile of logs to go to furniture factory. Children could work co-operatively to move tree children.</li><li>4. Talk about forests, sustainability etc.</li></ol>	
<b>Assessment opportunities:</b>	
CD - using imagination to play a role. CL & L - use of words relating to parts of a tree etc.
