Celebration and Charity Days in March

Please find below some information on Celebration and Charity days that we will be taking part in across the Centre during the month of March:

World Book Day – Thursday 4th March

As a charity, World Book Day is here to change lives through a love of books and shared reading, and bring books to the children who need them most. To help celebrate World Book Day children are invited to either come in fancy dress as their favourite character from a book or to wear their Pyjamas. Each child will receive a £1 World Book Day token which can be used to redeem against the cost of a book or a £1 book for free through local booksellers.
