Signs of Autumn and Nocturnal Animals

- Help your child to develop their independence. Let them practise putting on their own wellies and coats. Encourage them to have a go at doing their zip up.
- Go on an Autumn walk around your local area. Talk about the signs of Autumn you can see. Collect items such as conkers, leaves and pine cones to use when at home.
- Use the items collected to create crafts at home. Make a conker character using googly eyes and Sharpie pens. Create an autumn collage with the leaves collected or a magic wand from a stick using sequins, ribbons and glitter.
